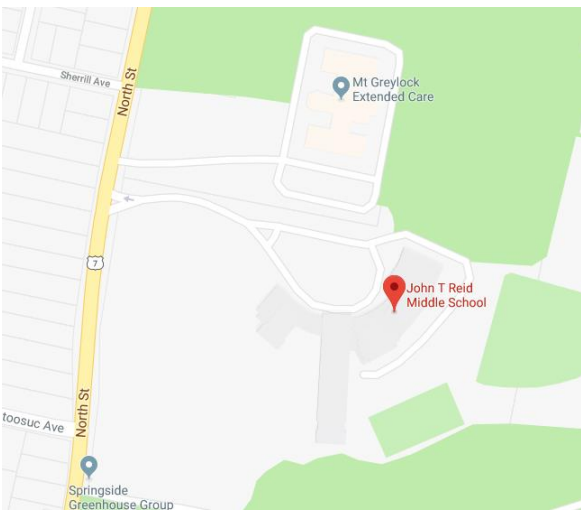

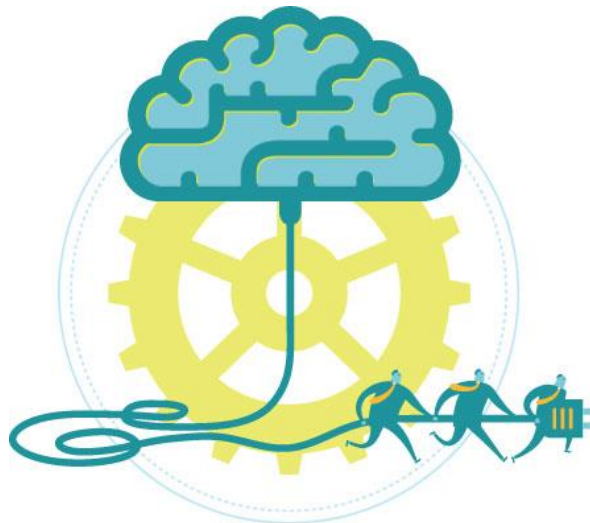

2. STEM is Child's Play: Incorporating STEM Concepts in Your Program
